Special Events Instructor Job Description

Sienna Ranch is a farm and nature program with school year classes and summer day camps serving kids age 4

*Special events instructors are also eligible to work one-off special events, such as scout trips, private events, and school field trips on Wednesdays. These are scheduled and staffed based on demand and are not a required part of the Special Events Instructor role.

***Mandatory training for this position will be on Saturday September 7th & Sunday September 8th.**

This position reports to the Special Events Director.

Qualifications:

- Strong background working with children age 4-14
- Strongly encourage those with 1 year experience working in an outdoor education setting with children
- Comfortable working with children around animals, including chickens, goats, sheep, bunnies and horses
- Experience with outdoor skills, archery, farm animals and horse riding a plus
- Excellent communication skills and interpersonal skills, both with adults and children
- Ability to work well independently, and as part of a team
- A flexible yet professional teaching style, with the ability to improvise
- A solid back pocket of group management strategies suitable for children age 4-14
- Ability to solve problems independently, improvise to work around unexpected problems, and work without supervision
- Ability to adhere to our strict birthday party timeline, whilst remaining relaxed
- Current adult and child First Aid/CPR
- Ability to check email daily for administration communication

Responsibilities:

- Check birthday party picnic area for hazards and cleanliness before guests arrive
- Prepare all materials and activities for birthday party
- Communicate with other weekend staff about use of shared space
- Lead an introductory circle, introduce Ranch Rules
- Lead Sienna Ranch Birthday Parties and/or Field Trips, according to assigned curriculum making the experience fun and educational for all guests

- Take responsibility for the health, well-being and happiness of party guests while at the Ranch
- Pro-actively communicate with Special Events Director if supplies are low
- Encourage respect between party guests, and respect for the Ranch animals, equipment and facilities
- Can commit to one year of work. Plan on working most Sundays and an occasional Saturday. Work is based on the amount of events booked.
- Must commit to work the 4 large events we offer. See more below.
- Be the face of Sienna Ranch for our weekend guests
